A CHRISTMAS CHRISTINGLE: *You will need:*

1. An orange or satsuma
2. Four cocktail sticks
3. A small candle
4. A piece of red ribbon or red tape
5. Some small sweets / dried fruit / cubes of cheese

Instructions: Make a hole in the top of the orange, and put in the candle. The orange symbolises the world and the candle is Jesus. Put the ribbon around the middle of the orange. Fasten with sticky tape. The ribbon represents Jesus' love as it goes all around the world. Finally put some sweets, dried fruit or cheese on the cocktail sticks and put them into the orange. These represent the people in the four corners of the world.
